Schedule

- 3:00 pm Begin moving equipment/instruments/etc. to stadium
3:30 pm Rehearsal in stadium
4:20 pm Final run-through performance for middle school band
4:30 pm Set-up concert formation on track with middle school band; rehearse fight song
5:00 pm Band booster tailgate/dinner – introduce yourself to your sections middle school band and eat with them (Keep the areas clean! Plan on eating **OUTSIDE** weather permitting and let's continue to practice **SOCIAL DISTANCING** - six feet!)
- 6:00 pm Begin preparing for performance (changing into uniforms, taking care of hair, etc.)
6:15 pm WARM-UP
Woodwinds/Brass – meet at marching band tower
Pit/Battery Percussion – meet outside band room
Color Guard – meet in dance room
- 6:30 pm Line up/walk to football stadium
6:40 pm Set up concert formation (on track) for pre-game ceremony
6:55 pm Recorded music begins; when song starts to fades out play Fight Song. Perform national anthem.
Members need to immediately move to the bleachers on the track for the start of the game.
- 7:00 pm Football game begins (go Grizzly Cubs!)
7:25 pm Warm up for half-time performance (after the end of the 1st period break); pit prepare equipment
7:50 pm Line up for half-time performance on the north end of the stadium; prepare props
8:00 pm Half-time performance (Birdland, Empire State of Mind, My Shot, and part of NY NY?)
8:15 pm Pit moves equipment back to band room. Guard returns equipment back to storage room.
8:30 pm Winds and drum line returns to the bleachers to watch the 4th quarter. **Students MUST be in their seats by the END of the 3rd quarter.** Pit and guard return as soon as possible.
9:30 pm Football game ends; return to band room; change out of uniforms; clean up band/guard area
9:45 pm Dismissal (**everyone needs to stay until things are cleaned up!**)

All times during the game are approximate. Please remind your ride to be ready to pick you up after the game. We have our first contest on Saturday!

UNIFORMS – Winds will be wearing uniforms with fedoras! You should wear your black Blue Regiment performance t-shirt, black shorts/leggings, and **LONG**, black socks under your uniform. The Color Guard should plan on wearing your uniforms but make sure you have your black, Blue Regiment t-shirt and black leggings just in case. **You will want to wash your performance t-shirt overnight so it is ready for our contest day!**

Props and scaffolding will be stored inside the building after Friday night's performance/game for Saturday's practice/contest.

All cell phones and electronic devices must be left inside during the evening (from the beginning of warm-up until we return). Cell phones and electronic devices will be confiscated and turned into the office. Please make sure that all your valuables are locked in your lockers. It would be better to leave your valuables at home.

Make sure you also have your instrument, flags, supplies, and anything else you might need for the performance.
